NOTIFICATION/अधिसूचना

This is to notify, that, the following guidelines shall be in force in connection with RGUMPET, 2020, under which, the common entrance test for admission to Ph.D and M.Phil during the Academic session 2020-2021.

- RGUMPET 2020 shall be a common Entrance test for admission in both M.Phil.and Ph.D. courses
 for academic session 2020-21. The RGUMPET will be held in the RGU Campus only by observing
 necessary precautions and the norms of social distancing. More manpower should be engaged
 for sanitisation of the examination rooms and centres before and after each sitting.
- 2. Single admit card will be issued to the students who have applied for both the programmes. The Computer Centre will shortlist candidates belonging to three categories (Only M.Phil., only Ph.D., and both M.Phil. and Ph.D.) and issue the admit card accordingly.
- 3. The RGUMPET Committee will prepare the schedules of the Examination observing the COVID protocol in consultation with the Examination Branch.
- 4. RGUMPET shall be conducted in one seating for each subject/discipline of 3 hour duration giving a break of 15 minutes in between Paper I (MCQ, 1 hour duration) and Paper II (Descriptive, 2 hour duration). Paper I shall have subject based 50 MCQ of 2 marks each (with 4 options) without any negative marking. Paper II consisting of 100 marks shall have descriptive type questions as per the following pattern:
 - a) Section A: 4 Compulsory questions of 5 marks each (Answer limit 50 words)
 - b) Section B: 10 questions of 6 marks each (Answer limit 100 words) from a set of 13 optional questions
 - Section C: 01 question (Answer limit 300 words) of 20 marks out of a set of 3 optional questions
- 5. Candidates scoring a minimum of 50% mark in Paper I and II taken together shall be short-listed for each course and called for the Interview (viva-voce) in order of merit in 3:1 ratio against the vacant seats in the department/centre/Institute concerned including the RGUMPET exempted candidates. Maximum marks for Interview (viva-voce) examination shall be 50 without any minimum requirement of score for qualifying the Interview.
- Exemption of candidates from RGUMPET written test, Procedure of conducting Viva-Voce Examination, and Final selection of the candidates for admission shall be governed as per the existing University ordinance/rules/criteria in this regard.

These decisions are exclusively for the current pandemic situation and should not be cited as a precedent in the future.
