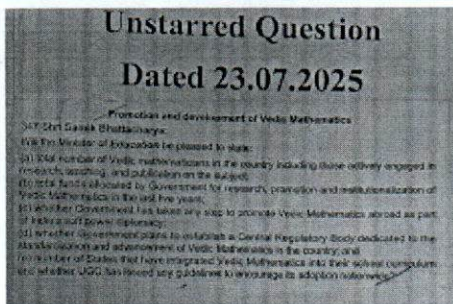



The University Grants Commission (UGC) has issued the <i>"Guidelines for Promotion of Physical Fitness, Sports, Student Health, Welfare, Psychological and Emotional Well-being at Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs)."</i> Under these guidelines, HEIs are encouraged to prioritize the mental health of students. Consequently, institutions may recognize mental health issues as valid medical grounds for relaxation in mandatory attendance, subject to the provisions and amendments in their respective University Ordinances and Academic Bye-laws. In our case also, RGU will follow the requisite guidelines.
(b)	whether there is a proposal to introduce "Wellness Days" (non-medical leave) for students in Higher Education Institutions, similar to corporate policies; and	Currently, there is no specific mandated protocol from the UGC for "Wellness Days" modelled on corporate structures. However, the existing UGC guidelines provide HEIs with the flexibility to adopt student-friendly practices that support mental well-being. Universities have the autonomy to adapt their leave and attendance rules to include proactive mental health breaks or wellness initiatives within their institutional framework to reduce academic stress. In our case, RGU has been providing leaves to students on case to case basis if any mental illness is reported by such students with supportive documentation from clinicians.

The UGC's latest norms on mental health emphasize the establishment of 24/7 helplines in all HEIs. In the context of Rajiv Gandhi University (RGU), the university has established a dedicated

		<p>counselling service center known as "Mano-Vimarsh."</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Service Overview: Mano-Vimarsh provides structured psychological counselling and mental health support specifically for the student community.• Professional Support: The center is staffed by counselling experts and mental health professionals.• Referral System: For cases requiring clinical intervention or advanced psychiatric care, the center maintains a referral linkage with the Tomo Riba Institute of Health and Medical Sciences (TRIHMS) and the Mental Health Hospital, Midpu. In exceptional and clinically justified psychiatric emergencies where specialised services are not available within the State, RGU has provisions to empanelled outstation psychiatric hospitals, following due referral, documentation, and approval by the Administration.
